

TCC Notes 19th November at St Francis Church Hall, Llay

TCC was founded in 1995 with Nia Hughes as the full-time worker. She was followed by Chris Pilsbury, a parishioner of St Francis, who did a lot of work to do with the chimney at Tunnel Cement, she even went to meet with the Chief Executive of the company in America. Previous work includes getting pavements in Bradley and access to the Post Office in Flint for disabled people before the legislation.

There are currently 2 part time workers Kay and Sam.

The idea was to give a voice to the little people and that everyone has the right to be heard. It is based on the American philosophy of Broad-based organising.

There are currently 30 local groups in Wrexham, Flintshire and Denbighshire. They range from faith groups, schools and community groups. There is a monthly meeting at which items for future action are discussed. Anyone from the group may attend. They are non-party political.

They set member dues (fees) based on the number in the group. They do have events organised to fundraise.
